





2011 POPULATION AND EMPLOYMENT DENSITY



Growth is Focused in Urban Centres




2011 – 2041 POPULATION AND EMPLOYMENT DENSITY CHANGES




Along Rapid Transit Network



2041 POPULATION AND EMPLOYMENT DENSITY










