



Columbus Avenue Bus Lanes

The City of Boston has installed the first center-running bus lane in New England along Columbus Avenue from Jackson Square to Walnut Avenue. In partnership with the MBTA, the City of Boston has implemented a range of improvements to Columbus Ave that will benefit bus riders, pedestrians, and the neighborhood as a whole.

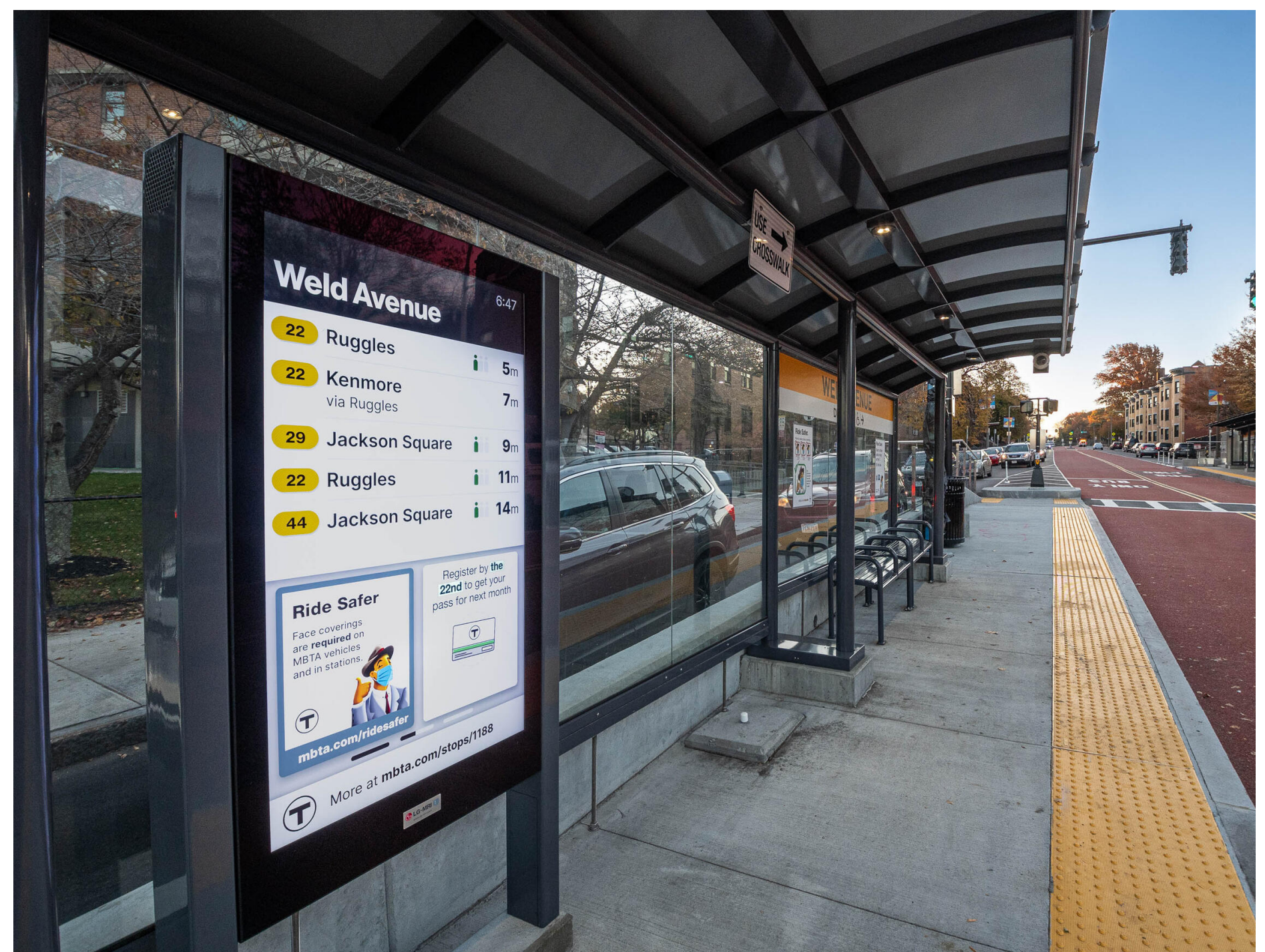


Columbus Avenue Bus Lanes



This project included a number of pedestrian safety and accessibility improvements, including new crosswalks, ramps, curb extensions, and safer crossings at the new stops.

New island platforms for bus stops with amenities including canopies and real time arrival signage were also installed along the new bus corridor.



By having dedicated bus lanes in the center of the street, conflicts with traffic and parked vehicles are removed. These improvements save riders 4-7 minutes along the corridor.
